1. General

The Club Pattinaggio Bellinzona, member of the Federazione Ticinese di Pattinaggio (FTP), is pleased to announce the **Trofeo dei Castelli 2016**, an International Figure Skating competition for Clubs with the following categories:

USP/ISU: Mini, Speranze, Advanced Novice, Junior, Senior B and Senior in single skating

Breitensport: Starlet 4 (without USP test), Interbronze, Bronze, Intersilver, Silver (amateurs categories)

The **Trofeo dei Castelli 2016** will be conducted in accordance with the ISU Constitution and General Regulations 2014, the ISU Special Regulations and Technical Rules Single and Pair Skating 2014, all relevant ISU Communications and the **Swiss Ice Skating Communication 2016/17, Required Elements for the Swiss Championships 2017.** For Breitensport Categories please refer to SEV website.

All ISU Members and Clubs, Members of National Figure Skating Federations associated with the ISU, are invited to take part in the competition. Passports or license of the skaters, as well as the ISU Clearance Certificate, if applicable, must be presented at the accreditation.

2. Technical Data

USP/ISU - All categories are organized according to the specification of the Swiss Ice Skating Federation for the Swiss National Championships. Please refer to Required Elements for the Swiss Championships 2017. For Swiss Skaters: dead line for passing test is August 21st, 2016.

Senior: Ladies and Men born before 1.7.2002

Short Program 2 min 40 sec (+/- 10 sec)

Free Skating Ladies: 4 min (+/- 10 sec)
Men: 4 min 30 sec (+/- 10 sec)

Applicable rules: ISU Seniors

Junior: Ladies and Men born between 1.7.1997 and 30.6.2003

Short Program 2 min 40 sec (+/- 10 sec)

Free Skating Ladies 3 min 30 sec (+/- 10 sec)
Men 4 min (+/- 10 sec)

Applicable rules: ISU Juniors

Bonus points: 1 bonus point for one triple jump, neither under rotated nor downgraded and 1 bonus point for an additional, tough different, triple jump, neither under rotated nor downgraded.

Senior B: Ladies and Men born before 1.7.1997 (Possible also for those born between 1.7.1997 and 30.6.1998)

Short Program 2 min 40 sec (+/- 10 sec)

Free Skating Ladies 3 min 30 sec (+/- 10 sec)
Men 4 min (+/- 10 sec)

Applicable rules: ISU Juniors

Bonus points: 1 bonus point for one triple jump, neither under rotated nor downgraded and 1 bonus point for an additional, tough different, triple jump, neither under rotated nor downgraded.

Novice:** Girls born between 1.7.2001 and 30.6.2006
Boys born between 1.7.2000 and 30.6.2006

Short Program 2 min 20 sec (+/- 10 sec)

Free Skating Girls 3 min (+/- 10 sec)

Boys 3 min 30 sec (+/- 10 sec)

Applicable Rules: ISU Advanced Novice according to ISU communication

Bonus points: 1 bonus point for one 2A and 1 bonus point for a triple jump,
neither under rotated nor downgraded.

(U13)** Girls born between 1.7.2003 and 30.6.2004
Boys born after 30.6.2002

Short Program 2 min 20 sec (+/- 10 sec)

Free Skating Girls 3 min (+/- 10 sec)
Boys 3 min 30 sec (+/- 10 sec)

Applicable Rules: ISU Advanced Novice according to ISU communication
1947

Deduction: -0,5 by fall

Bonus points: 1 bonus point for one 2A and 1 bonus point for a triple jump,
neither under rotated nor downgraded.

Mini (U12) Girls born after 30.6.2004

Short Program 2 min 20 sec (+/- 10 sec)

Free Skating Girls 3 min (+/- 10 sec)
Boys 3 min 30 sec (+/- 10 sec)

Applicable Rules ISU Advanced Novice according to ISU communication
1947

Deduction: -0,5 by fall

Bonus points: 1 bonus point for one 2A and 1 bonus point for a triple jump,
neither under rotated nor downgraded.

Silver: Ladies and Men no age restrictions

Free Skating Ladies 3 min 30 sec (+/- 10 sec)
Men 4 min (+/- 10 sec)

Applicable Rules ISU Juniors

Bonus Points: 1 bonus point for one 2A, neither under rotated nor downgraded

Inter Silver: Girls and Boys no age restrictions

Free Skating Girls 3 min (+/- 10 sec)
Boys 3 min 30 sec(+/- 10 sec)

Applicable Rules ISU Advanced Novice according to Communication 1947

Bonus Points: 1 bonus point for one 2A, neither under rotated nor downgraded

Bronze: Girls and Boys no age restrictions

Free Skating Girls and Boys 3 min (+/- 10 sec)

Applicable Rules ISU Advanced Novice according to Communication 1947, with the exception that there is the *same program content and length for both girls and boys.*

Deduction: -0,5 by fall

Inter Bronze: Girls and Boys no age restrictions

Free Skating 2 min 30 sec (+/- 10 sec)

Applicable Rules Inter Bronze

Deduction: -0,5 by fall

Starlet 4: Girls and Boys no age restrictions

Free Skating 2 min (+/- 10 sec)

Applicable Rules Without USP test

Deduction: -0,5 by fall

3. Entries and deadline

All ISU members and clubs, members of National Figure Skating Federations associated to ISU, are invited to take part in the competition. In case of too many entries, the Organizing Committee reserves the right to limit the number of participants.

Entry must be done with the attached Entry Form. The Entry Form and the "Planned Program Content Sheet" for each competitor must reach the Organizing Committee no later than **August 28th, 2016** at the following address:

4. Charges

Each competitor is requested to pay 120 CHF or 110 € entry fee for USP/ISU categories and 90 CHF or 85 € for Breitensport (amateurs) categories.

Payments must be made no later than September 7th, 2016. In case of withdraw entry fee will not be refunded.

5. Expenses

Travel expenses, accommodation and meals are at the charge of the participants

6. Liability

The organizer will provide Medical Emergency Aid during the competition. In accordance with ISU General Regulations, rule 119, the organizers assume no responsibility for or liability with respect to bodily or personale injuries or property damaged incurred by participants, officials or third parties in connection with the event.

7. Music

Music will be reproduced from a CD player. Each program (short program, free skating) must be recorded on a separate CD. CDs must be submitted at the time of registration.

8. Calculation of results

The marking system (ISU Judging System as described in ISU Special Regulations and Technical Rules Single Skating, rule 352) will be applied for all categories.

9. Draws

The starting order for free skating will be the short program result in reverse order. Consequently draws will not take place.

10. Awards

The top three competitors of each category will be awarded with a trophy. The other participants will receive a medal.
